Shanti Home (or Radisson Hotel), Delhi



Shanti Home reflects Indian spirit in a harmonious blend of tradition and contemporary sophistication. Exquisite interiors, impeccable service and fine cuisine combine to create an experience that is warm and intimate. Shanti Home has a small number exclusively designed rooms and suites.

Kanha Earth Lodge, Kanha National Park



The Lodge architecture has been inspired by the stunning Gond tribal villages which are situated on the fringes of Kanha, making it blend effortlessly with the forest and rural architecture. The lodge offers a small number of beautiful open-fronted bungalows with en-suite bathrooms and dressing rooms, and large open verandas set in sixteen acres of jungle. All bedrooms are air-conditioned, and a hundred percent power back up for the erratic rural supply is guaranteed.

King's Lodge, Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve



Kings Lodge is nestled in a large natural forested estate of eight hectares in Rancho village. The lodge is in the heart of wild country and only ten minutes drive from the Tala gate of the national park. Guests benefit from its incredible location, outstanding hospitality team, and local commitment towards conservation and local communities. The lodge has ten cottage rooms and eight stilt cottage rooms with en-suite modern bathrooms spread across a natural forest offering great ambience and privacy.

Reni Pani Jungle Lodge, Satpura National Park



Reni Pani Jungle Lodge is an exquisitely designed conservation and wildlife-focused lodge located close to the Satpura National park and Tiger Reserve. The camp features twelve luxury cottages encompassing three distinct structural designs, a cosy central meeting place called the Gol Ghar and a jungle pool. The lodge is spread over thirty acres of striking forest cover typical of the Satpuras'.

Lion Safari Camp, Gir National Park



The Lion Safari Camp is a new luxury jungle safari camp at the famous Gir National Park – the last remaining bastion of the Asiatic Lion. It is the first Luxury Jungle Safari Camp of its kind in Gir National Park. It is located in a private mango orchard overlooking the Hiran river. The location presently has around nine hundred mango trees with only two percent of the entire land area being built. The accommodation consists of twenty luxury tents, with large en-suite bathrooms. The public areas consist of an open-air river-facing restaurant.
